Notes:

1	The daily schedule is applicable for 6 days of the week, with noted exceptions. The daily schedule does not apply to Sunday's.
2	Play from 6:00AM - Noon will be by designated skill level only. EXCEPTION: Wednesday's will be "play up" days, (inside and outside) where you can play up one skill level. There will be a limit of 1 lower level player per court. RAC players count as one of the play-up players. Anyone can play down at any time, but must change play to match the level.
3	Skill Level Court Play from 6:00AM - Noon 1. Play will be 4 on 4 off, meaning that after each game all four players MUST ENSURE there is no one waiting to play before initiating another game. 2. Paddle racks will be used to coordinate play. DO NOT MOVE ANYONE'S PADDLE BUT YOUR OWN! 3. Any player who's name is on the rating advancement sheet (Has a Rating Advancement Card - RAC card) for the current week is permitted to play with the group they are challenging into, inside and outside. The rating advancement list is posted outside the gym in the shadow box.
4	Play from Noon - 10:00PM will be available for any group to play. EXCEPTION: Some time slots will be reserved on a weekly basis 1. Academy 2. Player Development Training 3. Shootouts 4. Open Group Play

5	<p>What is Reserved Open Play? Any play that is regularly scheduled (e.g. Monday Couple's Play, CC/C Ladies) that is open for anyone to join, and is regularly attended may request from the scheduling committee a time slot. The committee will observe for a few weeks to ensure attendance continues, and then it will be added to the schedule.</p>
6	<p>Private/Closed Group Play - While the club encourages and promotes "Open" play, private/closed group play is also allowed. Private/closed group play is when someone organizes play with a limited number of players. Often this is done as invitation only. Sometimes a close group of friends just wants to play together socially. Sometimes a small group may want to gather for tournament preparation. Whatever the reason, private/closed group play is absolutely permissible. However, the club will not guarantee and reserve courts for this purpose. Courts are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Private/Closed group play is only allowed on courts not scheduled for club use.</p>
7	<p>Rollover Courts - if any court is not being used by the designated group, anyone may use the courts. If members of the designated group show up, rollover players should finish their game, exit the court, allowing the designated group to play.</p>
8	<p>Challenge Courts:</p>
	<p>1) On Tuesday, court 1 on the A courts, court 8 on the B courts, and court 16 on the C courts will be designated "open" challenge courts. An open challenge court means that you and your partner play and winners stay. The winning team can play a maximum of 3 games at which point they must leave the court and get in line to challenge again.</p>
	<p>2) On Thursday court 1 on the A courts, court 8 on the B courts, and court 16 on the C courts will be designated "mixed doubles" challenge courts. This means that you and your mixed doubles partner play and winners stay. The winning team can play a maximum of 3 games at which point they must leave the court and get in line to challenge again.</p>
	<p>3) Challenge court guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. the waiting queue for A, B, & C challenge courts is in the Ramada. Paddle racks are not used for challenge courts. B. If both winners can't stay and play, both need to leave the court, along with losing team. C. Challengers are in pairs only. You must have a partner to challenge. D. Losing team in an opponents third winning match does not stay. Both teams clear the court. E. Challengers must be ready to play or next team will be up. F. No saving places while playing in other games. G. If the court is not being used as a challenge court, 2 teams may use the court as soon as play is over.
